Entering / Exiting

Please apply before the due date at the library counter. Also, it is possible to extend the due date through the "MyKULINE". You cannot extend checkout period if the books are already past their due date.

Reserving materials on loan

Reservations can only be made for materials currently on loan. Please apply at the library counter. Also, it is possible to apply for it through the "MyKULINE". We will contact you when the material is returned. Please come to the library counter within one week after being notified.

An individual can only copy a part of any library material for research purposes. Please use the photocopy machine on the 1st floor.

On the other hand, it is possible to request photocopies or borrow books from holding libraries in the case that the materials are held in the North campus, Uji campus, or distant campuses. Please make a request at the library counter or through the Medical Library website.

Requesting photocopies / books from other university libraries It is possible to request articles (for a fee) or borrow books which are not available in the South campus in Kyoto University from other libraries (Please note that borrowing books from other university libraries is for a fee.). Please submit the "Photocopy application form" at the library counter, through the Medical Library's website or "MyKULINE".

■ Visiting other university libraries (Reading Only)

It is possible to visit other university / institution libraries. Some libraries may require the presentation of student ID or personal ID, and some may require you to bring a letter of introduction. Please ask a staff member at the library counter.

** We are able to issue letters of introduction only for members of faculty of medicine or related institutes.


